

LIBRARY SPELLS

If I have two or more contours then or a race that give me spellcaster, do I get m two or more library spell choices at the appropriate level?

No. You simply receive one library spell choice at the appropriate level. You will have multiple spell colleges from your background. No matter how many colleges you have in your background, you are still just one spellcaster and can only advance at the rate of a single person. For instance: A professor may have degrees in both sociology and history but still must put on their pants one leg at a time.

INFECTIOUS ZOMBIES

OR "THE BIG OOPS"

The sing, very biggest edit miss in the entire rule book would be the skill set for infectious zombies. Obviously, the entire block of skills are inconsistent with the Zombie's description and attributes.

Here is the corrected zombie skill set.
1) HtH Unarmed 11, 2) Stealth 11, 3) Bite Mastery 7, Offhand 6, Mimic former life 2

Obviously other characters and even monsters have more skills than this. Zombies are much simpler than other monsters and lack the ability to more than chase food, bite food, and eat food. Zombies will not even act in their own defense. They are a completely reactionary creature like a virus or venus flytrap.

Even though the zombie can mimic its former life, it no longer has real knowledge, motivation or any emotional attachments.

WHAT'S IN A NAME?

One of the many obstacles in character creation for many players is the naming of a character. This chart may aid you in constructing fantasy names.

- 1 **The "Animal" + Name**
Example: The Wolf, Kasurta
- 2 **Verb only**
Example: Purge
- 3 **Name + the "animal"**
Example: Styleck the Serpent
- 4 **Simple Name**
Example: Thom
- 5 **Name + "analogy"**
Example: Richard the Lion Hearted
- 6 **"Title" + Name**
Example: Sir Duncan
- 7 **Exotic Name**
Example: Leth'Tarressos
- 8 **Complex, Exotic Name**
Example: Terramijax Nesperanza Carkarathu
- 9 **Noun only**
Example: Hammer
- 10 **Name + the "Object"**
Example: Jeremy, the wall
- 11 **Name + the "Adjective"**
Example: Phillip, the intrepid
- 12 **Name + "adjective and Noun"**
Example: Jon, the lost wayfarer
- 13 **First and last name**
Example: Jon Fuller
- 14 **Name + the "Profession"**
Example: Christirk, the Demonslayer or Otto the Smith
- 15 **Name + Inverted Name**
Example: Conner Rennoc
- 16 **"Season" + the "Profession"**
Example: Autumn the Mage
- 17 **"Animal" + last name**
Example: Condor Forogen
- 18 **Name + "Deed"**
Example: Domino, slayer of the shadow lord
- 19 **The character has no real name and changes his name according to necessity or whimsy**
- 20 **Character has two names. Roll separately for each. The odds are that one is an alias.**

Abilities by Level
L0. Spell caster: Witchcraft
L0. Gain skill: Animal Handling
L0. Gain: Diplomacy, Fast talk, Hide Tell
L5. Contact. Gain 1d4 contacts of the GM's discretion every 5 levels
L5. Gain Armored Lion Mount
L10. Speak with lions
L15. Gain Control of a Hyena Pack
L15. Speak with Hyena
L20. Gain Spy Network. Number of spies equal to pIT+ sCH. Gain one additional spy every level

Limitations
1. Familiar must be an owl
2. Must choose two skills from the following list: Seduction, Acting, Stealth, Climbing
3. Patron: Character serves another person or organization.
4. Feared and hated by family
5. Wanted for murder of a family member.
6. Bounty! Character has a bounty on his head equal to primary Charm in gp
7. A night witch is a murderous being and must take sadistic as an evil trait.

Starting Income: Normal
Description: Nightwitches are an eerie type of witch that serves both their own evil as well as the needs of a dire patron. They serve as advisor, spy, assassin and recon scout.

A nightwitch is a merciless individual that has proven their own murderous sadism through the murder of a family member. What the nightwitch will do for coin is beyond comparison.
